1. The Government of Tanzania has set aside funds for the operation of the **Magu District Council** during the financial year **2018/2019**. It is intended that part of the proceeds of the fund will be used to cover eligible payment under the contract for **which this invitation for tender is intended**.
2. The **Magu District Council** now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified drilling contractors registered with Drilling Agency and CRB as specialist contractors in the field of drilling works in class V and above to carry out Survey, Drilling of Productive Boreholes, Testing and Installation of Hand Pump as shown in the table below;

Qualification requirements include: legal status of the company (including registration with the Drilling Agency and CRB as a specialist contractor in class Five and above), proposed major equipment for carrying out the works, qualifications and experience of key personnel for administration and execution of the contract and financial status of the bidder.

A complete set of Tendering Document(s) in **English, in hard copy** may be purchased by interested Tenderers on the submission of a written application to the address given under paragraph 3 above and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Tshs.100, 000.00 (Tanzania shilling One Hundred Thousand Only)**.
6. All tenders must be accompanied by a tender securing declaration in the format provided in the tendering documents.
7. All tenders in one original plus one copy, properly filled in, and enclosed in plain envelopes must be delivered to the address below at or before **11:00 am on Friday 1st February 2019**. Tenders will be opened promptly thereafter in public and in the presence of Tenderers' representatives who choose to attend in the opening at the District Conference Hall.
8. Late tenders, portion of tenders, electronic tenders, and tenders not received, tenders not opened and not read out in public at the tender opening ceremony shall not be accepted for evaluation irrespective of the circumstance.
